Re: LVRT Management Plan

Dear Ms. Brassard and VAST,

We submit these as further comments on the LVRT management plan.

At the public hearing held on November 28, Bryant Watson gave the names, address, and phone numbers of the sheriffs who are responsible for law enforcement on the trail. We suggest that this information be clearly and prominently posted on the VAST website. In addition, the rules governing snowmobile use of the LVRT (curfew hours, speed limits, no trespass, etc.) should be clearly and prominently posted on the VAST website. This information must be available to the general public, especially adjacent landowners. It should also be important information for all snowmobilers who intend to use the LVRT. This information should also be on the VAST Trail Map, if it is not there already. Though VAST has no legal law enforcement authority, it has a civic responsibility to do everything it can to educate its members and to enforce the rules of the LVRT.

We suggest that this information be permanently posted on the VAST website. If and when a website is created specifically for the LVRT, this information should be posted on that website as well.
